CONSERVATION DISTRICT TECHNICIAN

Full-Time with Benefits – Salary: \$28,000 - \$30,000

Warren County Soil and Water Conservation District is seeking qualified candidates for the position of Conservation District Technician.

The Conservation District Technician is responsible for providing professional services in the planning and execution of soil, water and resource conservation programs and projects in the Warren County Soil and Water Conservation District including field surveys, design, construction, and supervision of conservation projects in accordance with standard well-established conservation practices and procedures.

Minimum qualifications: A) Graduation from an accredited four year college with a Bachelor's Degree in physical sciences, conservation, environmental studies, natural resources, forestry, soils, agronomy, agriculture or related field and one (1) year experience in natural resources protection, conservation, construction inspection, engineering, land surveying, forestry, or related field, OR

B) Graduation from an accredited two year college with an Associate's degree in physical sciences, conservation environmental studies, natural resources, forestry, soils, agronomy, agriculture or related field and four (3) years' experience in natural resources protection, conservation, construction inspection, engineering, land surveying, forestry, or related field.

Note: A Master's Degree can be substituted for one (1) year of required

Qualified Applicant must be a Warren County resident. Position will be filled based on Civil Service requirements. A provisional appointment will be made with examination to be held at a later date. Candidate must meet Civil Service requirements for appointment following establishment of an eligible list.
