Replacing Valuable Documents

In the event of loss, the following offices and agencies can be contacted for the replacement of government-issued documents. Fees may apply.

County Clerk: All recorded land documents (deeds, mortgages, discharges), Court Filings inc. Judgments of Divorce & Separation Agreements, Certificates of Incorporation, DBAs, Filed Survey Maps, Liens, Military Discharges, Notary information, Passports. **(518-761-6426)**

County Dept. of Motor Vehicles or NYS DMV (1-800-CALL-DMV): Motor Vehicle records: license, registration, title. **(518-761-6438)**

County Family Court: Child Custody Documents, Adoption records. **(518-761-6500)**

County Health Department: Medical Files, Immunization, Public Health Emergencies. **(518-761-6580)**

County Real Property Tax Service or Local Assessor: Parcel Information, Valuations. **(518-761-6464)**
