SUNY ESF PACK DEMONSTRATION FOREST - TOWN OF WARRENSBURG, NY



- Surface Type:** Two-track (dirt road)
- Difficulty:** Easy/Family-Friendly
- Length:** 4.1 miles
- Time to Complete:** 1-3 hours
- Trailhead Coordinates:** -73 48.88 43 33.25
- Trail Notes:** Start off on the trail to the south of the parking lot and follow the mostly flat loop around Pack Forest Lake in a counter-clockwise direction. The trail passes some huge pine trees, and interpretive signs describe the area. Dogs are welcome.

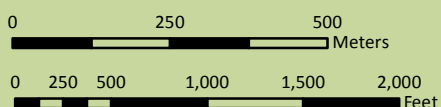


Directions and Parking:

From the South: Take the Northway to Exit 23. Turn left and then right onto US9. Go through Warrensburg, past the intersection with NYS 28. The entrance to Pack Forest will be 1/4 mile after this intersection on the left. Follow the entrance road and bear to the right to the parking area. There are no parking fees.

Things to Do Nearby:

Pack Forest contains many other recreational opportunities, including paddling, fishing, picnicking and a variety of hiking trails. The Grandmother Tree Trail, a one mile walking trail with interpretive signs through an old growth forest containing one of New York's historic trees, is just south of the bike loop.
