# What is Public Health Education?

Public Health is more then monitoring and enforcing rules to keep our communities safe. It is also about helping people make healthy and informed decisions to prevent disease, injury and unhealthy choices by the use of health education.

Warren County's health education program is a **FREE** service that offers a variety of presentations on a number of current health topics. Our health educator often can develop a program to meet the needs of your group. Presentations can be offered on site or at the Warren County Municipal Center.

Program staff can offer services and support to community groups, schools, families, seniors/retirees, individuals and the general public who are looking to make a positive difference in their health and well-being.



## Presentations already prepared for you!

#### Family Emergency Preparedness —

With Warren County's Family Emergency Preparedness program you will gather the basics about how to be prepared in any situation including starting a family communication plan, keep important records safe, how to stay informed, things to consider for special needs people and more.

Healthy Eating — This program will help individuals and families understand the basics of good nutrition, how to find and use nutrition tools available online, how to better understand food labels and what to look for when talking about food and serving sizes.

Seasonal Safety — This presentation can be done in parts or as a whole program. It includes the latest information on Ticks & Lyme disease, West Nile Virus, Rabies, Sun Safety, and even Poison Ivy. A great general safety program for the warmer months.
