REMARKS ON THE HARVEST OF 1864.—Here state whether the yield of any particular crop, reported on the preceding schedule, was affected by drouth or other causes, to what relative amount as compared with common years? The oat crop of 1864 was severely affected by drouth the yield being but one fourth that of the preceding year. It appears that dry crops seriously raise the corn, by the late rains which the potato crop only much. all other crops were more injured than the potato crop.

The number of domestic animals kept by those who occupy no farming lands, are 5-2 horses, 2 cows, 13 calves, 10 colts.

REMARKS ON THE MORTALITY OF THE YEAR ENDING JUNE 1, 1865.—State whether any epidemic or other natural or known causes operate, and the number of deaths. In December 1864 and for the year ending June 1, 1865 I received no returns on the subject of small pox but 3 persons died enough to be in bed, very healthy here at present.

REMARKS ON THE INFLUENCE OF THE WAR UPON PRICES.—What is the average monthly pay (including board), of farm laborers through the six months ending June 1, 1865? What were these wages in 1860? 12.00 Has the price of farming lands increased since 1860? No State the increase. I don't know. How has the war affected the amount of debt between individuals? It has diminished it. What effect has it had upon credit? It has increased it. Has it tended to promote prompt payments? It has. How has it influenced the amount of currency in circulation? It has increased it. How has it influenced pauperism? Diminished it. What other changes in the social condition of the people have you observed since 1860? A general thing that has been a marked improvement in this respect, especially in the western population. A large proportion of the population is now in the increased circulation of newspapers and the general amount of reading done by the average person; and also to the general comfort obtained by means of the various rail & telegraph lines.
